The sites selected are without internet and hardline phone support. As such, the County EM has requested ARES resources to supply needed communications for the operational period. ARES resources have been requested for each of the POD staging sites, the Primary POD, the County ECC and the West county ECC. In addition the County EM has requested us to keep messages and traffic somewhat secure. #### Goals

2. Support the ARES mission in Oregon.
3. Gain access to and activate OADN equipment at the county EOC per agreement.
4. Introduce, train, and evaluate new personnel on the EOC amateur radio equipment
5. Each county shall identify two county needed goals or ARES unit specific goals that they would like to see accomplished.

6. To help radio amateurs gain experience in communications using standard procedures and a variety of modes under simulated-emergency conditions.
